**Subject: Water Conservation Measures and Updated Water Rates**

Dear Residents,

Due to ongoing drought conditions and increased demand on our water supply, Tom Green County Fresh Water Supply District #2 is implementing **Stage 3 Water Conservation Measures**, effective immediately.

These measures are necessary to ensure that our community maintains an adequate and sustainable water supply for essential needs. Under Stage 3 restrictions, the following guidelines will be in effect:

- Outdoor watering is limited to these designated days and times:
  - Even Number Addresses (Water on Sunday & Thursday)
  - Odd Number Addresses (Water on Saturday & Wednesday)
  - Watering Hours (Only allowed between 8:00 pm and 10 am)
- Use of water for non-essential purposes (such as washing driveways, sidewalks, or vehicles at home) is prohibited.
- Restaurants will serve water only upon request.
- All leaks must be repaired promptly.
- Filling of swimming pools and use of decorative fountains may be restricted.
- Hose-end sprinklers prohibited
- Fire hydrant water use for construction is prohibited

We ask all residents and businesses to cooperate fully with these measures. Conservation at this stage is critical to avoid further restrictions and to protect our water resources.

Failure to comply with these regulations may result in penalties, as outlined by local ordinances.

We are also writing to inform you of an upcoming adjustment to your water service rates, effective for the April 2026 billing cycle. This change is necessary to ensure the continued reliability, safety, and quality of the water services we provide to our community. The average residential customer will see no increase in their monthly bill. However, increases will affect high-water users. Highlighted in red are the new rates:

Minimum to 1,000 Gallons	\$62.50
1001 – 2000 gal	\$4.00 per 1000 gallons
2001 – 3000 gal	\$5.00 per 1000 gallons
3001 – 10,000 gal	\$7.00 per 1000 gallons
10,001 – 20,000 gal	\$14.00 per 1000 gallons
20,001-and over	\$28.00 per 1000 gallons
